

ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING PAX LUGGAGE

- Large **PEDs** (Personal Electronic Devices) should be carried in the passenger cabin whenever possible;
- Ensure that any large PED that cannot be carried in the passenger cabin (e.g. due to its size), and therefore has to be carried in checked baggage, is:
 - Completely switches off and effectively protected from accidental activation. To ensure the device is never powered on during its transport, any application, alarm or pre-set configuration that may activate is shall be disabled or deactivated;
 - Protected from the risk of accidental damage by applying suitable packaging or casing or by being placed in a rigid bag protected by adequate cushioning (e.g. clothing);
 - Not carried in the same baggage together with flammable material (e.g. perfumes, aerosols, etc.);

Furthermore, where carry-on bags are put in the hold (e.g. due to the lack of space) ensure to remove from the bag any spare batteries or e-cigarettes.
