

SAFETY OBJECTIVES

The operational safety objectives of **CLIPPER NATIONAL AIR** are:

- 1. Maintain and continually improve the effectiveness of our Management System.
- 2. Identify all the hazards of the operation, including those that may arise from any changes that may be created by subcontracted companies, analyze their risks and have effective mitigating measures in place and keep them under control over time.
- 3. Ensure the qualification and competence of all personnel.
- 4. Continually promote voluntary occurrence reporting and report all reportable occurrences.
- 5. That all company personnel are aware that operational safety is their first responsibility.
- 6. Comply with all applicable legal requirements and standards.
- 7. To have the resources to comply with them.
- 8. Ensure that subcontracted companies meet CLIPPER NATIONAL AIR's performance standards and goals.

CLIPPER NATIONAL AIR will always take into account the safety objectives established by the Spanish Operational Safety Action Plan (PASO).

Any action determined to be taken in relation to the objectives will be set forth in the Company's Action Plan.

To monitor the objectives, the indicators established to measure safety performance will be analyzed periodically.

They will be reviewed at the CRS and distributed to all **CLIPPER NATIONAL AIR** personnel and subcontracted Companies via the website, in conjunction with the Security Policy.
